Footnotes

VICAR OF LA bumped with foe at the start and was a bit slow to begin, moved up steadily, closest to the leader in the turn, collared that foe from the outside entering the stretch, drew steadily clear late. RUBICUND moved early along the inside to be clear before a quarter, continued to maintain a daylight advantage in the turn, vied with the winner past the furlong marker, could not match strides late, just held the place. AUTHENTIC FLYER chased the leader early, fell back a bit turn, getting back to the runner up late. ONE MORE WEEK fell back to trail soon after the start, roused five wide out of the turn, finished willingly while too late. CONGA ROCK bumped at the start, improved along the inside into the stretch, flattened out a bit the final furlong. CAMERONLUCKYPRIDE five wide through the turn, lacked a late kick. POLY SAUCE settled in mid pack soon after the start, had little left for the drive. TWO NICKEL BUD steadily faded.
