STAND pressured the leader outside that rival, moved to challenge turning for home, long drive, put a head in front a furlong out, fully extended to narrowly prevail. GENERAL PARTNER moved up soon after the start to set the pace inside, continued to show the way into the stretch, proved stubborn. TIZ A SCHOLAR evenly paced for six furlongs, moved closer along the inside late in the final turn, moved out to be three wide for the drive, could do little with the top two the final furlong. SUPREME DAY evenly paced throughout in lacking a late bid. STONE SKIPPER forwardly placed and three wide into the first turn, was finished before a half. DIMITRI off a step slow, trailed throughout, distanced after losing contact with the field in the stretch.
