SAY THE WORD unhurried early, advanced toward the inside far turn, steadied midway on that bend, waited briefly, moved out, roused, up in time. LATCH LIGHTING set or forced the pace along the inside, could not contain the winner, held the place. HAWK WALKER vied up front three wide through the first turn, fell back onto the backstretch, bit closer turning for home, coming again late for the place. SWEET DIXIELAND devoid of early foot, saved ground second turn, displayed some late interest up the rail after the issue had been decided. DAVY'S PRODUCTION vied up front three wide through the first turn, continued to contest the pace the middle half mile, weakened in the drive. LEESTOWN LEGACY lacked a response in the drive. WALKINTHEBLUEGRASS with the pace while four wide through the first turn, stopped.
