GIANT APPEAL asked to maintain inside position after the start, showed the way backstretch, dueled into the stretch, headed, came back. SIPHON RIO pressed the winner early, engaged that one from off the rail turn, gained the advantage when straightened for home, faltered a bit as was outfinished by the early leader who came back. MISS BEAN WAH closest to the top two from the outset, three wide turning for home, could do little with the first pair the final furlong, remained well clear for the show. WITCH'S VENTURE void of early foot, saved ground, made a late run up the rail after the issue had been decided. FRISKY ROCKET failed to mount a bid in the drive. SUNDAY RIDE also made little impact while racing just off the inside. VICKIES IN TOWN four wide late in the turn, tired. SEFAS BELLE faded. MACARENA LAUR last away after breaking to the inside slightly, not a threat. STORMY'S GIRL was outrun. LYRA LEE stopped in the drive.
