MARKED TIME closest to the leader, collared that one while well out in the strip with less than a furlong remaining, edged clear. DIRT ROAD CAT broke alertly, sprinted out to a long lead soon after, could not match the winner in the late going, clearly second best. MAD POET lacked speed, raced just off the inside turn, roused, up for the show between foes, no match for the top two. BLAZE VENTURE raced back early, moved out to be well wide for the drive, did not have enough for the show spot. DADDYS FOUR QUEENS turned in an even effort while lacking a late kick. LULA MAC forward placed in the early going, faded. CAPOTETTA lacked a rally. FANCY BAND off slowly, passed tiring foes well after the issue had been decided. SLEW RULER dwelt at the start, remained well back throughout. WOLF ROAD SWEETIE wide trip, outrun. TRINKET staged a steady retreat. RUSTY'S JURY shortened stride after a quarter, pulled up rail, vanned off.
