**Footnotes**

TRUHAWK outrun early, made a good run through traffic in the second turn, drove clear. BLUE DUCK pressed the early pace, took over to narrowly show the way before a half, shook briefly clear in upper stretch, could not contain the winner. GOTHIC'S GOODBYE forwardly placed, bid second turn, fell back off the runner up again upper stretch, trying to get back to that one, outfinished for the place. GLENNWOOD PARK off the pace, shuffled back slightly in traffic in the second turn, lacked a winning kick. I'M THE DADDY void of early foot, found best stride too late. WAJIR ON ME off the pace, moved closer four wide in the far turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. SURREPTITIOUS set the early pace, vied the middle half mile, weakened when the real running started at the head of the lane. NAJA HAJE lacked a late bid. BOBBYN BOUIE last away, remained back throughout. BOBBYS HOLIDAY was finished after a half.
