PRIVATE FLIGHT unhurried in the early going, moved inside to save some ground, advanced closer along the rail second turn, briefly boxed turning for home, rail bid soon after, kicked well clear. INDIAN BLUFF behind the early leaders, advanced with an early move up the rail to challenge into the far turn, showed the way into the lane, allowed the winner the rail upper straight, no match for that rival while holding sway for the place. PINK STILETTO settled off the pace and the inside, raced four wide through the second turn, finished up best of the rest. POPCORN SUNSET lacked speed, moved out to be five wide turning for home, managed a mild rally to improve position. STORMIE BABY five wide into the first turn when with the leaders, continued to vie outside in the run up the backstretch and through the final turn, came up empty for the drive. FLYING BINGO devoid of early foot, came six wide into the stretch, managed little in the way of a late rally. SPICY GRAVY forwardly placed early, began a steady retreat before a half. MANDY ON BROADWAY showed the way early, vied middle half, backed up in the drive.
