OUR LOVE with the pace along the inside, shook. clear of the other speed turning for home, increased advantage under token encouragement. PRINCE OF A DEAL brushed at the start, raced back, four wide into the lane, rallied for the place while no threat to the winner. LOVE MOUNTAIN within striking distance behind the pace, lacked a significant late kick, even finish, caught for the place. MR. EXCELLENT turned in an even effort while racing toward the inside. TEST OF TIME set or forced the issue for three furlongs outside the winner, gave way when the real running started. GRAND BANK lacked a response in the drive. RENT A PRINCE saved ground when well back through the turn, came up empty. TIGER MONARCH was always outrun. FORTYNINEACREWEST in a bit tight at the start, trailed.
