Footnotes

BRENTWOOD BULLET never far back off the inside, advanced three wide out of the final turn, challenged nearing the ground grounds, gained the advantage, fully extended to narrowly prevail. ROYAL AND FLASHY last away, raced well back for a half, advanced, roused for the drive, came out slightly when continuing to rally midstretch, late bid, missed FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY AND A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF LEE'S SPIRIT AGAINST THE RUNNER UP FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND.. HALLWAY allowed to settle off the inside, came four wide out of the final turn, flattened out a bit late, finished up evenly to prove best of the rest. MESA SUNRISE saved ground throughout in an even effort. LEE'S SPIRIT void of speed, advanced, lacked room when ROYAL AND FLASHY drifted out slightly inside the furlong marker, did not recover. SWEETSOUTHERNMOON got clear and toward the inside early in the first turn, set the pace until headed by the winner midstretch, faltered. SILENT PIPE closest to the leader for six furlongs, also tired in the drive. TOGA'S STORM raced briefly forward, was finished after a half.
