DEBI DIAMANTE away well from the outside, soon well clear and toward the inside, breather turn, steady handling drive. BRUSHING BY YEA settled off the early pace, advanced to be closest to the winner while off the inside late turn, continued to make slow progress on that rival the final furlong. WHO THAT MISS ANN off a bit slow, raced back off the pace while out in the strip, four wide into the turn, five wide out, saved the show in the late going. SHESASUSPECT saved ground when outrun into the turn, moved out around a tiring foe midway on the bend, went evenly through the stretch. YELLOW PACKAGE shuffled back at the start, steadied early with a half mile remaining, continued back through the turn, displayed some late interest while not posing a serious threat. BRITT'S SPECIAL forwardly placed in the early going, fell back, evenly through the stretch. FLYING IZABELLA failed to menace. HANDLE SCANDAL chased the winner early, began to retreat before three furlongs. DESISTERROSE fell back, trailed throughout.
