WINDING ROAD second flight outside, moved closer on the outside into the far turn, vied three wide into the stretch, proved best under firm handling. EDPLICIT bobbed slight and broke in to help pinch back JOSHUA REYNOLDS, settled in the second group early as well, advanced, bid between rivals second turn, long drive, could not match the winner late, gained the nod for the place while between horses at the wire. MANDIMAX void of speed, saved some ground into the lane, moved out for room, finished up willingly while widest at the wire to be in time for the show. FRIEND OF INDY dueled up front early off the inside, put the other speed away just as the top two came calling in the second turn, proved stubborn in the drive until late, narrowly missed the show. COTEAU CAT turned in an even effort throughout. JOSHUA REYNOLDS pinched back at the start, trailed for a half, advanced four wide turning for home, failed to sustain that effort the final furlong. MAJHOOD lacked a rally. WAKKIANO broke out slightly, mid pack early, began to fade before a half. SIERRA MAESTRA dueled early along the inside and stopped after five furlongs.
