Footnotes

VIRGINIA PRIDE four wide in the first turn when within striking distance, continued to stalk while in hand backstretch, bid second turn three path, gained the advantage and held sway late. CONSERVE allowed to settle early, moved a bit closer in traffic second turn, waited briefly, finished willingly to be clear for the place. CAMPINOUT forwardly placed early, shuffled back while along the rail late in the second bend, went evenly through the stretch to earn the show. DRIFTWOOD LODGE lacked early speed, advanced five wide turning for home, failed to sustain that effort in the final furlong. O K CARACEY sprinted briefly clear in the first turn, showed the way backstretch in hand, had little left for the drive. CELLARS MERLOT no response drive. RED HAWKEYE rank and steadied at the start, fell well back to trail, saved ground, no threat. PRICE OF CHAMPAGNE lacked rally. SILVER ON SILVER set or forced the pace for a half and stopped.
