DURKIN'S CALL outrun early, made a strong move four wide into contention turning for home, reached the leader nearing the furlong marker and wore that foe down. FORMAL DECREE allowed to settle unhurried early, quick move four wide to take over turning for home, could not match the winner in the late going. HUMBLE CHRIS void of early foot, raced in traffic exiting the final turn, rallied to annex the show. DRIFTWOOD LODGE last to leave, trailed, found best stride too late outside. COMMANDER BUCK steadied at the start, again in traffic entering the stretch, finished evenly. FORUM RULES broke on top, showed the way into the first turn, continued to set the pace for over six furlongs, gave way when headed by the winner turning for home. GO STAR BUSTER had nothing for the drive. WOLF TRICK forwardly placed for six furlongs, stopped in the drive. DUSTY TUNNEL closest to the leader for a half, faded. RED SOLDIER steadily retreated, finished well back.
