DIP'S DOUBLE broke on top, set the pace out in the strip, remained comfortably clear in the drive under steady handling. TUTT chased the winner in vain throughout while also out in the strip, held sway for the place. SUNBROOK broke to the inside, raced back early as a result, steady advance off the inside, getting to the runner up late. CAJUN CHILUKI void of speed, raced five wide through and out of the turn, improved a bit in the drive. JOYFUL STREAM moved closer while four wide through the turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. SHECKY LUCKY LEE away in good order, raced closest to the winner early, began a steady retreat before a half. SENSATIONAL SARAH had little for the drive. LITTLE SQUIZ finished early, trailed home while running through standing water for much of the stretch.
