Footnotes

THE BOSSER outrun while saving ground, behind horses into the stretch while trailing, altered course to the far outside, finished well to be in time. OPPORTUNITY LOST also void of early foot, came four wide out of the final turn, rallied, late bid, missed. CAT'S PRODUCTION settled off the pace and the inside, raced in traffic nearing the furlong marker three path, up for the show. NATIVE HOLLY off the pace, also was in traffic stretch, bit tight rail, improved slightly late. PRODUCTION'S IDOL four wide into the first turn when pushing the pash, dueled in the run up the backstretch off the inside, continued to vie through the second bend and upper straight, weakened the final furlong. SWEET EUGEENA within striking distance most of the way, lacked a closing kick. ROYAL MADAME also came up empty for the drive. FREEZE CAT broke alertly, narrowly set the pace toward the inside until a furlong remained and gave way.
