GOODBYE BEAUTIFUL closest to the leader, engaged that one from the outside turning for home, long and spirited drive, proved best. ZARPEN broke on top, got clear early, set the pace, responded when the leader came alongside for the drive, gave ground grudgingly. KISSMELIKEUMEANIT lacked speed, saved some ground into the stretch, rallied through and around traffic, finished willingly to be best of the rest. TELL NO TALES settled up front along the inside, lacked a closing kick. TUNNEL TIME also off the early pace, angled out a bit for room in the drive, finished up evenly. DOLCE DIVA lacked a rally. MISS CAJYN remained back throughout. WAHTOWAH BABY was never involved. PRETTY CHILE within striking distance for six furlongs, stopped in the drive.
