STAKES Chapel Belle S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLD FILLIES. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 once or \$20,000 twice at a mile or over in 2004 allowed 3 lbs.; Non-winners of \$20,000 once or \$10,000 twice at a mile or over in 2004, allowed 5 lbs.; Non-winners of \$15,000 once or \$7,500 twice at any distance in 2004 allowed 7 lbs.; No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box on Wednesday, May 19 and an additional \$250 to start on Saturday, May 22 with \$50,000 guaranteed of which \$30,000 to the winner, \$10,000 to second, \$5,000 to third, \$2,500 to fourth, \$1,500 to fifth and \$1,000 to sixth. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Should this race not be divided and the entry number exceeds the starting gate capacity, high weights will be preferred. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second part of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Nominations closed Friday, May 14, 2004 with 20 nominees. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 1 Mile and 70 Yards) (Rail at 20 feet).

TOPANGO unhurried early while saving ground through the first turn, moved to to begin her advance second turn, came five wide when moving smartly into the straight, finished full of run to be well clear. YOURSMINEOURS set a comfortable pace while well within herself, asked for a bit more second turn while inside, continued to show the way past the furlong marker, proved no match for the winner, while holding sway for the place. SMOKEY DIPLOMACY stalked the pace in hand and saving ground, continued to enjoy a good trip into the stretch, lacked a winning response in the drive. OUTRIGHT BUCK in traffic first turn, continued off the pace, between foes second turn, improved her position slightly through the stretch while never a serious threat. HOWL AT THE MOON last away, devoid of early foot, continued to trail into the stretch, moved to the far outside and displayed some late interest while too late. JOSIE G. within striking distance, lacked bid drive. GOLDEN DIVA forwardly placed first turn, moved a bit close on the outside under a pulled onto the backstretch, began to fade before six furlongs. LUCKY TUNNEL prompted early leader, steady retreat after a half.
