ZARBA THE GREAT stalked the pace off the rail, challenged the leader when straightened for home, edged clear late under firm handling. PUNCHIN' GAL pressured the early leader outside that one, dueled through the turn, narrowly showed the way into the stretch, gave ground grudgingly to the winner. DEEP GREEN evenly paced throughout, up for the show. GO GIRLFRIEND GO lacked a late bid. LADY PARTEE set the early pace inside, continued to show the way through the turn by a narrower margin, weakened after losing the advantage turning for home. CHOCTAW LADY was not a serious threat. LEESTOWN LIB also failed to menace. CEDAR SUMMER showed little in a dull effort.
