Footnotes

TORO BRAVO with the pace from the start inside, vied three wide through the turn while holding a narrow advantage, disposed of the other speed when straightened for home, drew clear. GOODIFITGOES off the early pace and the inside, also came three wide out of the turn, drifted in a bit, finished up willingly to earn the place. DAPHNE'S TRIBUTE broke alertly, vied up front while between foes, could not match the winner in the drive, weakened a bit more late, caught for the place. AMANECER DE ORO lacked early foot just off the inside, moved out a bit in midstretch, improved slightly while never dangerous. RUNNINGFORTHEGOLD also made little impact. DREAMSRUNWILD failed to menace. WE ARE BLESSED forwardly placed in the early going outside, faded. WHO DAT GHOST off a bit slow, not a threat while outside. PALE BLAZER contested the pace closest to the inside, stopped in the drive. DANGER INTENTION finished early, outrun.
