STAKES Louisiana Cup Turf Classic S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. (Includes \$100,000 from Slot Revenue). WEIGHTS: Three Year Olds 118 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 3 lbs. Non-winners of two other than maiden, claiming, or starter at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 5lbs; Non winners of one other than maiden claiming or starter at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 7 lbs. By subscription of \$100 on or before May 8, \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start with \$100,000 Guaranteed to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth with any unpaid monies reverting to the purse account. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses with highest money earned in 2009-2010. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second part of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Nominations closed May 8, 2010 with 22 nominees. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 1 1/16 Miles). (S)

Footnotes

SNUG settled off the pace, advanced and challenged three wide midway on the final turn, took over, edged clear late under firm handling. SNAKEBITE KIT forwardly placed, moved to the fore between foes, led, outkicked late. KISSIMMEE KYLE raced in some tight quarters into the first turn, settled onto the backstretch, moved closer toward the inside into the far turn, finished up evenly in lacking a late punch. SMOOTHCIDEUP void of early foot, improved while saving ground second turn, moved out a bit for the drive and continued willingly to the finish. WILDRALLY raced in the middle of the pace off the inside,

shuffled back late in the final turn, dropped inside for the drive and made a late run. NOWANDFOREVERMORE well back, raced in some traffic second turn, displayed some late interest after the issue had been decided. TWILIGHT ROSS back early, lodged a mild middle move four wide the middle half, failed to sustain that effort in the late going. UP AND OUT OF SITE lacked a rally. HALLWAY made little impact. CANDIANO last away, trailed, passed tiring rivals. AUTOBEACAT narrowly set the pace, stopped when headed. DESSY pressured the pace for five furlongs and also stopped. FIESTY DAY staged a steady retreat.
