KAT'S COURT outrun in the early going, began to advance from between foes midway on the turn, challenged outside the leader past the furlong pole, drove clear. WHERE'S CAIN with the pace while three wide and between foes, narrowly showed the way into the lane while continuing in the three path, could not match the winner the final furlong, saved the place. STRIKE IT in the second flight, came four wide out of the turn, getting to the runner up late. PRINCE OF APRIL set or forced the pace while between foes for a half and then weakened in the drive. GLENDA'S MAHALO off the pace and the inside, came five wide out of the turn, lacked a significant late kick. THE REVEREND JAMES last away, not a threat. YOGI AND BOO BOO four wide into the turn, faded soon after. COMEON HAYNESVILLE moved up inside, showed early foot, gave way.
