CAN'T COMPLAIN broke alertly, soon got clear, breather through the turn, not threatened in the drive under token encouragement. LEESTOWNS FINALE chased the winner in vain throughout while off the inside, clearly second best. EAGLE FALLS behind the pace toward the inside, two path turn in traffic, moved out a bit for the drive, up for the show. LYPHARD'S GOLD lacked speed along the inside, waited briefly behind traffic midway on the turn, moved off the inside, improved position into lane, note enough for the show. HALF ANGEL broke out, bumped foe, settled outside in the second group, four wide turn, failed to respond in the drive. BANTA lacked speed, in some traffic in the turn, improved position stretch after the issue had been decided. SILVER DOLLARDERBY forwardly placed in the early going out in the strip, faded. WHATS UP MACK slow to start, dropped inside, traffic late in the turn, passed

tiring foes late while never a factor. PEANUT TWO settled off the pace, weakened late. ALARMING SOUTH bumped at the start, hung out five wide through the turn, tired through the lane. TWO CROWNS stumbled badly at the start, remained always back. MAY SING THE BLUES well off the pace, six wide late in the turn, faded.
