CAPTAIN CRANE broke sharp, set all the pace, lengthy stretch duel closest to the inside, narrowly proved best in a game effort. NOT TOO PROUD pressured the winner from off the inside, long drive, outfinished. MARGO'S VENTURE in tight at the start, lacked speed, staged a mild rally on the outside to earn the show, no threat to the top two. ANNA'S GLORY void of early foot, continued to trail second turn, found best stride too late. ZARB'S WHIRL had little for the drive. SAVING STARDUST saved ground to no avail. DELTA DIAMOND forwardly placed for a half, faded. SPEEDY BEGONE staged a steady retreat before a half, well beaten.
