SLIGO JOE away well, pressured the early leader, took over onto the backstretch, continued to set a moderate pace, widened, ridden out. DUSTY TUNNEL allowed to settle early, advanced three wide second turn, could do little with the winner in the final furlong, clearly second best. GALLOPING HOME fell back to the second flight before a half, dropped to the inside for the drive, managed a mild rally to be clear for the show. LION MAN lacked speed out in the strip, continued outside for the drive, never dangerous. COMMANDER BUCK moved closer in the second turn off the rail, gave way soon after. SABOR was never factor. CAPTAIN ABOVE set the early pace along the inside, retreated.
