PLEASURABLE AFFAIR broke alertly, set the early pace in hand while off the inside, shook clear and to the inside entering the stretch, responded when challenged late, dug in late to prevail in game fashion. RUN FREELY back off the pace, made a steady gain three out to four wide in the turn, challenged the winner late from the outside, denied, fully extended to hold the place. SQUATER forwardly placed early along the inside, shuffled back through the turn, set down when clear for the drive, finished willingly late while between the top two at the wire, getting to runner up. WAR DEBT back off the pace, came five wide out of the turn, remained widest in the drive, improved position. HIGH WIRE DANCER broke in then steadied at the start, raced back off the pace, four wide turning for home, managed little in the way of a rally to finish up evenly. CAJUN EXPECTATION raced outside and toward the front early, moved

closer with a three wide mid move in the turn, failed to sustain that advance in the drive. GIACOMORE lacked speed, remained back turn, four wide into the lane, passed faltering rivals. JAMI ROAD in a bit tight at the start, raced back, also came four wide into the stretch, little impact late. SMOKIN ART hopped at the start, never a threat. BANK THIEF second flight early, began a steady retreat before a half. STRONG DOG was through early. TUFFY TUNA fractious in the gate, flashed early foot inside, stopped, distanced after losing contact with the field late.
