Footnotes

BIEHNEUREUX patiently handled behind the pace off the inside, bit closer late turn while still in hand, moved out for room past the furlong marker, bid, gained the advantage a proved determination. C'MERE LUCY stumbled at the start, trailed early, came four wide out of the turn when beginning to rally, lodged a late bid while widest, outkicked final strides. AMY MY AMY moved up to contest the issue off the inside, garnered a larger advantage in the turn after shaking off the other speed, clear a furlong out, could not contain the top two. DANCING DUDETE raced in mid pack out of the chute, gradually fell back toward the inside to trail late in the turn, moved to the outside, displayed some energy out in the strip while too late. THE PIPSTER showed the way out of the chute, dueled into the turn closest to the inside, fell back early in the bend, evenly past the furlong marker, little left late. A LITTLE TRIBUTE stalked the early pacesetters off the inside, closer far turn, challenged between rivals with a quarter remaining, weakened in the drive. BETTY LOU moved up to challenge four wide late in the turn, faltered in the drive. BURNINGRICH within striking distance early along the inside, faded. AUTHENTIC DEB was finished early.
