CROSSING THE TAPE away in good order, pressured the pace on the outside, took over in the three path turning for home, edged clear. DE RASCAL broke well, showed the way into the turn, dueled inside the winner entering the stretch, no match for that foe the final furlong, comfortably held the place. LA BELLE CAT chased the top two throughout, finished up best of the rest. STORM TRIP lacked early foot, came five wide into the lane, staged a modest rally while not a serious threat. SEXII N YOUKNOWIT void of early foot, improved position late while never dangerous. LEESTOWN LILLIE off the pace, came four wide into the straight, failed to muster a late kick. PERDIDO'S HOLIDAY raced in mid pack early, had little for the drive. STELLAR CAT failed to menace. BRASSY LIL BROAD broke slowly, trailed throughout in showing little.
