Footnotes

BANTA behind the leaders toward the inside, asked, angled out three wide exiting the second turn, roused, challenged nearing the furlong marker, kicked clear. SMART DRESSED GUY in a bit tight at the start, raced back in lacking speed, three wide and between rivals into the lane, finished willingly. FAST TIME STREAKER forwardly placed past the wire the first time, came out to bother a couple of rivals into the first turn, tracked the leader the opening half, moved up inside to challenge into the far turn, vied past the furlong marker, unable to match strides with the winner late, drifted out final strides to impede BEAUTY'S PIONEER. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE INCIDENT IN THE WANING STRIDES, FAST TIME STREAKER WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM THIRD AND PLACED SEVENTH. WALK EASY broke on top, showed the way early by daylight well off the inside, continued off the inside middle half, dueled second turn and began to weaken into the lane. PRADO'S MAIN MAN turned in an even effort while racing off the inside. WAYSTOGEAUX saved ground most of the way, lacked a rally. BEAUTY'S PIONEER lacked speed, raced in some traffic in the second turn, raced inside stretch, checked up in tight quarters late. NATIVE BOY bothered into the first turn when FAST TIME STREAKER came out, remained always back. ONE SURVIVOR also bothered into the first turn, raced forwardly for five furlongs and began to retreat.
