SPEIGHTER MAN unhurried in the early going, ranged up into contention while four wide turning for home, bid inside the furlong grounds, drove clear. POWERSCOUT also raced back off the early pace, steady advance while three wide, took over when straightened for home, could not contain the winner, well clear of the rest. MIDNIGHT RULES four wide into the first turn, challenged outside the leader in the second turn, showed the way into the stretch, no match for the top two, comfortably held the show. ROYAL TAK settled off the pace, behind several horses in traffic turning for home, moved out a bit for room, went evenly to the wire. BALIDOR DESOL narrowly showed the way early, slightly larger advantage up the backstretch, dueled far turn inside, gave way when headed. PRATT STREET trailed early after a slow beginning, six wide turning for home, improved position slightly while not a threat. AFLEET HALO raced in mid pack early, had nothing for the drive. AFTERMEYOUREFIRST back off the pace, steadied in tight into the far turn, remained back in failing to rally. SOUPER EX contested the early pace, stopped.
