Footnotes

CAJUN MAID outrun in the early going, came in the three path when moving closer late in the turn, collared the leaders past the furlong marker, kicked well clear. ELLA'S DEELITE broke out, raced in the second flight turn, six wide out of the turn, finished willingly down the middle of the strip to be clear for the place, no match for the winner. BAILEYS PRIDE pressured the early leader, lodged a bid in the turn, between foes into the lane, had little for the top two the final furlong, saved the show. RULERS ROSEALEE forwardly placed, three wide midway on the turn, got out a bit to the five wide when beginning to tire entering the stretch, finished up evenly. ANOTHER SHOES broke sharp, set the early pace, vied turn closest to the inside, continued to contest the issue up front upper stretch, gave way in the final furlong. BATTLE SILK last away, trailed for three furlongs, passed tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. DAECALLHERDASTREAK in the second group for three furlongs, tired in the drive. ITSJUSTBLOOD was never a threat. BOOK OF BUSINESS was also always outrun.
