JOYCE'S REBEL stalked the pace while off the inside, moved closer out of the turn, challenged past the furlong marker, well clear late under continued firm handling. METEOR ATTACK moved out and up to vie for the lead on the outside before a quarter, slightly larger lead late in the turn, could not match the winner late, game for the place. SNOW ON THE BAYOU outrun in the early going, angled out to be five wide into the lane, set down for the drive, missed the place. TENSAS CANEBRAKE also raced off the pace, four wide into the lane, lacked a significant closing response. CAJUN CAVEMAN broke well, veered in leaving the chute, raced within striking distance in the second flight and inside the winner for a half, faded. STORM OSIDY last away, failed to menace. NORTH WASHINGTON away in good order, set or forced the pace for a half while toward the inside, gave way in the drive.
