HY HAND POKER chased the winner throughout, could do little with that foe in the drive, remained clear for the place. WILS REWARD raced one paced throughout, finished up best of the rest. BAND OF FUN lacked a late response while racing off the inside. J D'S SILVER JETT last to leave, continued to lack any speed, made little impact in the drive. MR. ARGUMENT in hand in the early going, asked for some run while five wide out of the turn, came up empty for the drive. IMAHEMI tired after a half. WEEKEND RULER veered into the temporary rail exiting the chute, unseated rider.
