SERA'S TUNNEL within striking distance early, asked along turning for home, late surge to be in time. CANTOUCHTHISGAL four wide into the first turn when off the pace, advanced, outside bid in the second turn, shook clear, faltered late. SAMBA G last away, trailed early, five wide into the stretch, found best stride too late. SENT settled early, moved a bit closer in some traffic late in the final turn, failed to muster a closing kick. ST. TRIBUTE pressed the issue early, moved up to vie in the run up the backstretch and into the far turn, gave way in the drive. LIGHTUP THE SHADOW off the pace, moved a bit closer while four wide and in traffic late in the final turn, no late bid. CAPOTETTA tired from early efforts. NORTHERN WINN broke on top, clear early, vied, stopped in the drive..
