CAPE TOWN BRIDE unhurried for a half off the inside, came on the outside for the drive, roused, in time out toward the middle part of the strip. LADY TAMER within striking distance early inside, lost some position while saving ground turn, switched out when straightened for home, finished willingly to be in time for the place. FEEL THE GREED off the early pace, three wide through the turn when moving a bit closer, vied past the furlong marker, not enough in the late going. SWEET BOSTON LADY prompted the early pace, took over upper stretch, faltered soon after. ALY MAE WYNNE back off the early pace, raced four wide through the turn, lacked a closing kick. LITTLE SANTAYA broke on top, showed the way out of the chute, continued to set the pace turn, stopped when headed upper stretch.
