Footnotes

ARTIES T BALL outrun in the early going toward the inside, behind horses into the far turn, got through, three wide gain into the lane, in time. TRESS ducked out at the start cutting ASPEN TRAIL off, straightened, prompted the pace, took over from the outside turning for home, headed by the winner nearing the furlong grounds, no match for that rival, held sway for the place. FOREVER BLUE settled off the pace, moved closer on the outside through the second turn, failed to sustain that advance in the drive, finished up best of the rest. SWEET ACTION got clear before a quarter, set the pace for six furlongs, weakened in the drive. ASPEN TRIAL cut off at the start, trailed early as a result, continued back, improved position with some belated interest. STARFISH four wide through the first turn, lacked a response in the drive. LOUISIANA SHINE forwardly placed in the early going, faded after a half. SWEET INTUITIONS was never a factor. UP TOWN MARY was finished after four furlongs.
