LEESTOWN'S OMEGA broke out, stalked the pace along the inside, continued to be patiently handled along the rail through the turn, moved out, bid, proved best under spirited handling. TIN CAT broke on top, set the pace, in hand through the turn while still in hand, responded when challenged by the winner into the lane, gave ground grudgingly to that foe. PELHAM forwardly placed, between foes and within striking distance in the turn, lacked a winning response in the drive. DEDUCT back off the early pace, loomed five wide late in the turn, hung in the drive. PROVOKE ME raced outside and off the pace, in traffic while four wide late in the turn, went evenly when clear for the drive. TWIN CITY THUNDER close up, three wide and in some traffic late in the turn, gave way in the drive. MALACO in traffic, behind horses early, steadied in continued traffic into the turn, lacked a rally in the drive. WILDCAT'S SLEW off slowly, bothered at the start, remained back. JAMI ROAD bothered at the start, trailed throughout.
