TOO MANY DETAILS rated behind the pace toward the inside, challenged along the inside nearing the furlong grounds, got clear, held the runner up safe late. FIRST CROWNED also patiently handled for six furlongs, set down for the drive, slowly gaining on the leader. PRECIOUS METAL MAN lacked speed, roused, angled out then back in stretch, staged a mild rally to be along for the show. RADIO LOVER pressured the early leader, narrowly showed the way into the stretch, allowed the winner the inside soon after, weakened. HILLBILLY CAJUN settled off the pace, evenly, lacked a late kick. KING REX narrowly set the pace, faltered. HULA HEIAU last away, trailed early, floated out five wide turning for home, never dangerous. OWN THE RANCH remained back, four wide out of the final turn. KNOPPERS FORD finished early.
