Footnotes

ST. SEAMUS away in good order, moved out to be three wide into the turn, stalked the leader through the bend, challenged on the outside when straightened for home, drew clear under brisk handling. BOSSIER CITY alternated up front while off the inside, vied past the furlong marker, could not match the winner to the wire, dug in late to gamely prevail for the place while between foes. SOUTHERN VALUES dueled up front closest to the inside, missed the place. STORM HALF evenly paced in the second group, lacked a late response. PERILOUS CROSSING raced off the inside, also lacked a serious late kick. RUN BRICK RUN raced just off the inside, within striking distance turning for home, had little left the final furlong. MICHAEL'S BOY tired. EAGLE FALLS five wide late in the turn, tired. IMPULSIVE PASS always outrun. HEARTOFTHEMISSON last away, fell far back, distanced.
