### Footnotes

BOWLING firmly rated while within striking distance early, off the inside, three wide into lane when moving to challenge, long drive, gained the nod. FLEE THE POSSE outrun in the early going, advanced four wide second turn, lodged a bid outside the winner late, missed the nod. HOTTERTHANU allowed to settle, behind leaders into the lane, set down, finished up best of the rest. J. BURLE off the pace while saving ground, continued inside second bend, altered course to the outside for the drive, staged a mild bid to improve position. JOHN LOUIS CLASSIC chased the leader through moderate fractions, took over, weakened. CARSON CONNECTION well back, was asked along in the second turn, did not fire down the lane. RED OAK RIDGE lacked a late response. SNOOK sprinted clear to set the pace, gave way when headed into the lane. SHYBOY trailed most of the way in a dull effort. PATSY'S PROM DATE was finished early.
