Footnotes

DAWN'S TRIBUTE behind the pace toward the inside, waited under tight restraint through much of the turn, got through upper stretch, bid, edging away late. ZAMANDA'S RULING also in the second flight, lacked room in traffic late in the turn, split foes nearing the furlong marker, finished up well clear of the others. SWEET LEXI lacked speed, roused for the drive while still well back, rallied through traffic late to be up for the show. A RAILPRO TOO last away, trailed well back for a half, came six wide out of the turn, found best stride too late. KIEV showed the way early, continued to be a pace factor until a furlong remained, weakened. CROWNING CHOICE pressured the pace off the inside, also had little left late. OPPORTUNITY LOST made little impact while five wide much of the way. QUE HORA ES was not a factor. HUNG UP forced the pace three wide for a half and gave way. GRETTLA TOOT four wide when toward the front through the turn, tired.
