JUNE AFTERNOON got clear past the wire the first time, set the pace while rating kindly, maintained a daylight advantage to the wire under steady pressure. CAJUN SKY chased the winner throughout, could do little with that foe off the inside in the drive, held the place. STONE SKIPPER within striking distance while saving all the ground, also lacked a late punch, gained the nod for the show while continuing inside. DANGER INTENTION off the early pace, moved to a forward position the middle half, flattened out in the drive, missed the show.. PRECIOUS METAL MAN lacked early foot, improved position through traffic while not a serious threat. ORIGINAL DESIREE off the pace, came five wide when asked for run into the lane, made little impact. SASSY MAVERICK four wide most of the way, also failed to muster a late response. AUTOBESPEEDY off the pace, four out to six wide second turn, came up empty for the drive as well. WAIMEA CANYON tired from early efforts. IDEAL ZARB was never close.
