**Footnotes**

SKILLS COACH outrun for six furlongs, came four wide into the stretch when beginning to rally, finished with good late energy to be in time. SEVENAPRILADTHIRTY lacked speed, asked in the second turn off the inside, bothered slightly nearing the furlong grounds, up late for the place. BIG YARD BIRD settled behind the pace, continued behind a wall of horses into the stretch, steered out for room approaching the furlong marker, up late for the show while between foes. STRONG CITY settled off the pace, closer second turn, did not have enough in the drive for the place. ONEAFTERNOON went evenly lacking a late kick. LUMBERJACK CAT set or forced the pace until a quarter remained and began to weaken. SANDY MOMENT vied early, got clear backstretch, continued to vie through the second turn, faltered in the drive. CLEVEDALE last away, trailed for much of the way, never a threat. ROCK 'N RAIL was always outrun. BAMBOO GAP forward early, briefly vied for the lead the middle half, stopped.
