LADY DASHIELL forwardly placed, lodged an inside bid of her own midway on the second turn, showed the way midstretch after coming out a bit allowing the winner the rail, gave ground grudgingly to that foe late. CATHERINE'S LADY set the pace in hand, continued to rate into far turn, allowed the runner up the inside midway on the final bend, could not match that foe or the winner in the drive, saved the show. BARD'S DAY off the pace and the inside, firmly roused turning for home, improved position slightly, no real threat. MADMAD ELAINE saved ground to no avail. CORRIENDO RAPIDO settled off the pace, loomed boldly four wide midway on the final turn, came five wide into the stretch and hung. NET'S ALL N stalked the leader off the inside, challenged three wide and between rivals second turn, gave way in the drive. PROPER ONE lacked speed, wide in the drive, not a threat. DANCINGWITHNOMUSIC never involved. POLLYPRISSYPANTS was also never close.
