DUSTY TUNNEL off the early pace, advanced on the outside, wore down the leader while fully extended. MT. REE TAH narrowly showed the way early, shook clear in the turn, responded when the winner came alongside upper stretch, gave ground grudgingly. RIPROARIOUS pressed the runner up early along the inside, fell back off that rival in the turn, held the show. FEEDLEBAUM off the pace, asked along late in the turn while off the inside, lacked a late kick. KRISTYS BOONESMILL forwardly placed for a half three wide, had little left. WILD BUCK lacked a rally. WILD DINNER PARTY remained always back. RUNNERS NAME wide trip, outrun.
