Footnotes

DEGA PAPILLON allowed the pace to go, advanced and then collared the leader a furlong out on the outside, edging clear under steady handling. LEAR SONG also off the early pace, began to move closer into the straight, challenged between foes midstretch, second best. THEATRICAL'S HALO lacked speed after being in tight at the start, continued back into the lane, staged a belated rally out in the course, well clear of the rest. LIL JETT cleared to the inside, set the pace until straightened for home, weakened when replaced on the lead. QUILL OUT went evenly in lacking a kick in the drive. RUCKUS failed to respond. LASTRAW pressed the pace for six furlongs, gave way in the drive. ROCK 'N RAIL remained back. WAJIR ON ME last away, sluggish from the start, lost contact with the field, distanced.
