### Footnotes

BECKYBOY stalked the pace from along the inside, continued behind the first group under patient handling into the second turn, eased out for room upper straight, challenged between foes, drove strongly clear. COWBOY CADILLAC outrun in the early going, advanced four wide out of the final turn into contention, challenged while widest a furlong out, no match late for the winner. KELLY'SPREMONITION void of speed while under restraint, continued back far turn, also came four wide into the stretch, was going well at the end while too late. ARCTIC HUNTER showed the way into the first turn inside, got clear before a quarter, continued to set the pace up the backstretch and through the final turn, proved stubborn until late. WHY SEVENTEEN pressured the leader for six furlongs, weakened in the drive. NORTHERN LUST lacked a late bid. HALO'S THUNDER fell back to trail after the start, lacked a serious late kick. WESTERN SUN prominent while three wide for six furlongs, gave way in the drive. HONOUR ROCKET steadily faded.
