Footnotes

VALID NICK away in good order, dueled up front off the inside and in hand, pulled away the final furlong under steady handling. DEPUTY RED broke alertly, dueled closest to the inside, could not match strides with the winner the final furlong, just lasted for the place while continuing inside. KEEP ON SMOKIN lacked speed, came five wide out of the turn, found best stride too late while remaining well out in the strip, getting to the runner up late. GOOD FLAMIN FRYDIE lacked speed for a half, enjoyed a good trip along the inside into the lane, improved position while not a serious threat. TEN BEARS bobbed slightly then steadied at the start, lacked early foot as a result, made little impact in the drive. OLD ROME within striking distance early, tired while four wide. TOP CATS BULL moved up to be closest to the two leaders through the turn, had little left for the drive. DELIGHTED DISCIPLE chased the top two early, gave way in the turn.
