TOUGHMAN moved up to set the early pace, slightly larger advantage through the turn, shook clear when straightened for home, held late. SWAMP SHAKER lacked speed, raced four wide when beginning to advance late turn, continued to slowly be getting to the winner late, fully extended to hold the place. HESAPRIVATE void of speed, began to improve while saving ground into the lane, roused, finished with good late energy to be getting to both the top two. CANE RIVER broke sharply, vied early, chased the winner through the turn, weakened in the drive. COOKS FIREBREAK off a bit slow, failed to menace. POWDERHORN HEAT firmly rated behind the early pace, moved slightly closer in the turn, had little for the drive. SPEEDING FACTOR rank, steadied at the start, was never close. GRAY NOBLE forwardly placed for a half, prompted the winner through the turn, backed up in the drive.
