HALO MICHELLE broke on top, set a soft pace, remained clear into the stretch, proved no match for the winner in the late going. GIRL IN THE GROVE lacked speed, swung four wide out of the final turn, staged a mild rally, getting to the runner up. TENSAS CIEL saved ground while racing within striking distance, lacked a winning kick. GOODBYE BEAUTIFUL raced forwardly prompting the pace, came up empty for the drive. MEESHIANO saved ground to no avail. CARL'S FROSTY GIRL tired while steadily fading. MISTY'S HALO last to leave, lacked early speed, advanced with a middle move, gave way in the drive.
