ISLAND BLUFF away in good order, asked a bit early to maintain position, moved off the inside backstretch, tracked leader, collared that foe in the turn, gained the advantage and held the runner up safe the final furlong. C'MERE LUCY lacked early foot off the inside, good gain three wide into contention out of the turn, mild bid nearing the furlong marker outside the winner, second best. BONNIES JUDGE in the second flight while along the inside, roused while continuing to save ground out of the turn, shifted to the outside, slowly getting to the runner up late. CRAZYCOWBOYDREAM last away, trailed out of the chute, came into the stretch off the inside, improved position while never dangerous. MY MANDY GIRL broke in, bumped with foe start, got clear before a quarter, continued to show the way into the turn, weakened when headed by the winner midway on the bend. SELARI'S HONOR never menaced. HERE COMES NICE lacked a response in the drive. SNUCK IN GIRL bumped at the start, raced forwardly for almost a half then began to fade while four wide.
